

## CASE STUDY:

# JACK MOODY INVESTS IN TEREX FINLAY 770 TROMMEL AS PART OF EXPANSION PLANS

### SITUATION:

Jack Moody Limited, part of Jack Moody Holdings plc, recycle biodegradable and green waste, as well as inert waste from demolition sites, to produce various grades of compost, soil and aggregate. The company has also moved into new markets with the production of environmentally-friendly fuel in the form of 100% recycled wood chips and pellets. Operating from a 55 acre headquarters site at Cannock - designated as a 'best practice site' by WRAP - plus two satellite centres near Stafford and Telford, recent expansion of the business prompted Jack Moody Ltd to increase its fleet of screening plant.

### SOLUTION:

Finlay Plant Central – part of the Finlay Group of companies – has supplied Jack Moody Ltd with two Terex Finlay 770 Trak Trommels, bringing the number of trommels supplied by Finlay Group to the company to a total of five.

The 770 Trak model offers maximum on site mobility through a Twin Trak undercarriage, which can be operated via hand held radio control. Being self-contained with fully hydraulic functionality, the machines can be ready for work or transport within minutes - an important

materials for the construction industry. One of the 770 Traks was specified with a swivel fines conveyor to maximise stock-piling capacity. It is producing a minus 10mm top soil and clean, recycled 40mm drainage stone. The other is producing high-grade compost up to 10mm.
